Tas Carley Rafts

The Tas Carley Raft has been rotationally moulded from high visibility polyethylene with UV stabilisation, and a 2-part urethane core. The raft can accommodate 20 people, each holding a rope handle around the perimeter.

Designed and manufactured to the National Standard for Commercial Vessels (NSCV) requirements and mounted in a float free position on the boat/ship, the Tas Carley Raft forms part of safety compliance requirements for commercial vessels.

The linear low density polyethylene (LLDPE) fire retardant resin used for the outer casing is itself positively buoyant, and closed cell polyurethane completes the buoyancy requirements.

Flares

Flares are mandatory, both in commercial and most recreational vessels. We stock the highest quality brands of flares available. Built to SOLAS specifications, these signals are designed to work in freezing Southern Ocean temperatures, all the way to the warmth of the tropics – even after being immersed in water.

Life Jackets

An approved life jacket must be provided for each person on your vessel when out on the water.

Across Australia, many states require life jackets be worn at all times on any motor-propelled boat under six metres in length whilst underway. A life jacket is also compulsory for any lightweight craft including kayaks, canoes, paddle boards and yacht tenders.
